Being aware of some of the difficulties faced by migrants, such as 'culture shock', acculturation and integration can help us in our pastoral care.

Participants will look at some of the barriers to effective intercultural pastoral care such as awareness of language, being in touch with the unspoken, sensitivity to cultural differences and management of cultural discomforts.

Sr Margaret, a Sister of St Joseph of the Sacred Heart for 20 years, completed her Masters in Pastoral Studies at the Loyola University Chicago. In addition to being a trained teacher she now works in pastoral care of migrants from South East Asian countries.
